## An Introduction

**H**ere are a selection of resources to assist the ministry and mission of your parish. You will find a section on how to help people find faith. These courses are useful in their own right for enquirers groups, baptism or confirmation preparation. All congregations would like to increase the life, vitality and growth of their members but sometimes the pathways that enable people to make a confident journey of faith are not clearly outlined in a Parish. Each Parish, and if not themselves, their cluster or deanery, should make space for such courses. Look at the section [Finding Faith](#) and see which one is suitable for you.

Using small groups as a means by which we are encouraged in our Christian formation has had a long history, if you are just starting out or need assistance and stimulus for new material the section of [Growing Faith](#) will be useful to you. There is much to choose from, including our own Department for Development's "**Lay Ministry Lite**", do plan ahead and build in some adult education and discipleship courses in your parish. If none of the material suits you can always select some insights and create your own using some of the materials outlined here.

[Sharing Faith](#) has always been a challenge for timid and reserved Anglicans! The selection of courses under this section will encourage us to be outward looking and more confident in the expression and conviction of the faith entrusted to us. Churches that intentionally build this form of training in are those that lay a sure foundation for passing the Christian faith on to those around us. If it is not possible to engage sufficient commitment locally then try and run a course as a cluster or deanery.

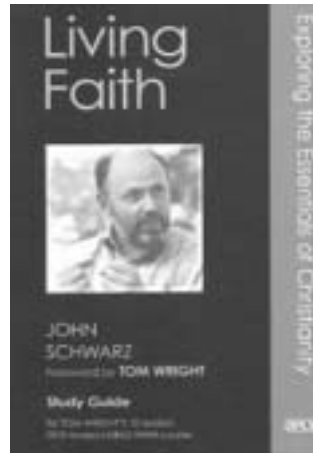
### Living Faith - Tom Wright

SPCK [www.spck.org.uk/livingfaith](http://www.spck.org.uk/livingfaith)

Exploring the Essentials of Christianity is a lively and absorbing 10-part course which is truly international in scope. It is for church Bible study groups and house/home groups (no special training is required for leaders), for personal study, for new Christians or anyone looking for a better grounding in the basics or simply some refreshment. In ten 25-minute sessions, Tom Wright offers a substantial introduction to each topic.

**Details:** 2 DVDs containing 10 sessions of approximately 30 minutes

each. Five copies of a Study Guide for those participating in the course (extra copies may be purchased separately). Leaders Guide which provides questions designed to help individuals or groups express their initial thoughts about the topics under discussion and to engage with the material in the Study Guide and the DVD (a free sample pack can be ordered from the above website). The DVDs come with five copies of the study guide and one leader's guide. The full pack costs £60. Extra



copies of the study guide can be purchased separately.

Discovering Christianity in six small-group sessions. The sessions assume no previous knowledge of anything Christian. They use a mix of DVD input, time to chat, simple discussion activities and space for reflection. All in a style that is down-to-earth and honest, and which aims to be enjoyable too. It is designed to help people think through where they

are going in their lives:

- Learn to ask questions about the Christian faith.
- Discover the good news of Jesus
- Consider how they want to respond to it - and to Him

**The people:** *Start!* is designed primarily for a group of about five to ten



members with two leaders. As well as those who want to know more about Christianity, *Start!* works well with baptism families,

wedding contacts, bereaved families, parents of children and teenagers and those who are new to the church.

**The place:** The chosen venue should be determined by the nature of the group. Some people find it difficult to come to a church, while others may be uncomfortable visiting a strange home. It can be best to find a public venue, such as a community hall. We've even heard of churches hiring a room at the local pub or coffee bar.

**Details:** The *Start!* pack comes with everything you

need to run a *Start!* course, including: A DVD with two clips for each session plus advice on how to get the most out of running a course. A course leaders' handbook explaining the aims and content of each session and providing photocopiable resources. A CD-ROM containing electronic versions of the members' booklet and resource sheets, plus alternative resource sheets and publicity materials, including artwork and logos. The sessions assume no previous knowledge of anything Christian. They

use a mix of DVD input, time to chat, simple discussion activities and space for reflection. All in a style that is down-to-earth and honest, and which aims to be enjoyable too.

For Christians seeking to develop their faith, personal lives and church community. Ideally for groups of 8-12 in a home group setting. Beta is an exceptionally well-produced, holistic, 10-week course linking Christian faith with personal

development and pastoral care. It aims to help people to:

- Understand more fully what it is to be Christian
- Become more whole
- Grow in Christian community.

The tone of the course is decidedly pastoral and therapeutic. Emphasis is placed on the importance of relationships (including our relationship with God) and the need for healing and wholeness in ourselves and



in our relationships. The course utilises a fascinating blend of biblical material, theology, and psychology. Each session of *Beta* is designed to last for one and

a half hours and includes:

- Bible Study
- Video presentation
- Group discussion
- Creative reflection
- Prayer

- Homework (private journaling and reflection)

*Essence* is a six-part course designed to be run off Church premises. It aims to give an experiential introduction to the Christian faith in a culturally relevant way. The overriding objective is to help people who may view themselves as 'spiritual' to journey towards the Christian faith. The course seeks to start where people are, so the concepts explored are all recognisable to those familiar with New Age spirituality. *Essence* seeks to help participants look at these concepts and issues from a Christian perspective.

The six sessions are:

- The journey so far
- The journey within
- The journey to a better world
- The journey to wholeness
- The journey to spirituality
- The journey to the future

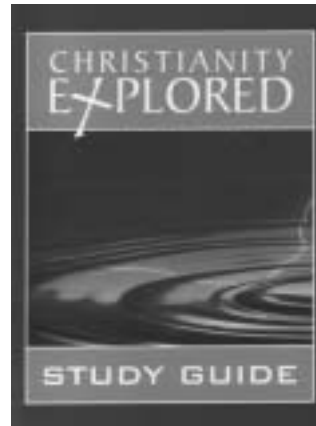

An integral part of Alpha is the weekend or day away where the focus is on the person and work of the Holy Spirit. After the talk, guests are divided into groups of ten to twelve people, hosted by a group leader and two helpers, in which they remain for the duration of the course. The talks act as a catalyst for open discussion in an

environment where each person should feel free to ask or express whatever they wish. At the end of the course a party is held to celebrate the completion of the course - which also gives a great opportunity for guests to show their friends and family what Alpha is about. *The Alpha Course* works best as part of an ongoing process of evangelism and discipleship within a church. There is a range of different follow-up materials and courses available to help people to grow in their faith.

**Comment:** *The Alpha Course has had a number of years exposure in the Christian press and comes as a package which can be used by local churches. Of particular note is that the talks on Alpha Express are shorter. Some churches are finding that a preliminary course is needed before the Alpha course is started, namely it assumes too much knowledge.*

## Emmaus - for adults

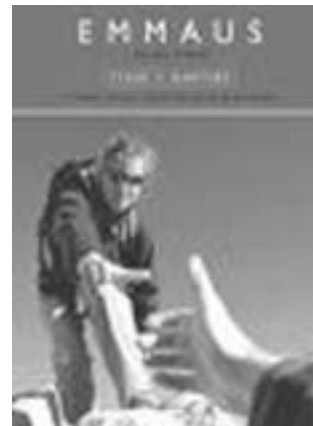

*Emmaus: The Way of Faith* is a course designed to welcome people into the Christian faith and the life of the Church. It aims to involve the whole Church in evangelism, the nurture of new believers and ongoing Christian discipleship. The *Emmaus* course progresses through three stages - contact, nurture and growth. It begins by encouraging the vision of the local church for evangelism and giving practical advice on how to develop contact with those outside the church. The course material

provided includes a 15-week nurture course that covers the basics of the Christian life and four growth books that offer Christians an opportunity to deepen their understanding of Christian living and discipleship.
