We all receive direct mail from companies offering us their products and services. In life this can be an irritation but when we die the postman can become an unwelcome and upsetting visitor for the family we leave behind.

And this upset turns to anguish when direct mail is targeted by fraudsters. Impersonation of the deceased and identity fraud are a national problem. All it takes is for a utility bill or credit card application sent after an individual has died to fall into the wrong hands for your loved one's identity to be stolen. Over the last 6 years The Bereavement Register has become instrumental in the fight against this disturbing and growing crime.

Simply by registering, thousands of organisations will be able to identify that the registered person has died and remove their details from their databases.
